CASE NAME: SEVEN SANDWICH SURPRISE


## Answer: BICYCLE

There are sixteen four-letter words, and twenty clues. Each clue clues a seven-letter word which can be created by injecting a three-letter substring of the form "aba" into one of the four-letter words. As an example, "Beethoven's Moonlight, and others" can be formed by using the given four-letter word "SONS" and injecting "ATA" to form "SONATAS".

Doing this for all sixteen given four-letter words, in the order given, yields:

| DIVE | +STS | DIVESTS | Gets rid of |
| ARMS | +ADA | ARMADAS | Great fleets |
| SINS | +UOU | SINUOUS | Snakelike |
| CLOT | +SES | CLOSEST | The one most near |
| PENT | +ASA | PEASANT | Commoner |
| SING | +OLO | SOLOING | Doing by yourself |
| ALLY | +TOT | TOTALLY | In its entirety |
| PEAK | +COC | PEACOCK | NBC mascot bird |
| SONS | +ATA | SONATAS | Beethoven's Moonlight, and others |

Now, reading down the center letter of the added triplets, we get four more words, which can be matched up with the remaining four clues:

| LONE | +ABA | ABALONE | Large, edible sea snail |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| PERT | +SIS | PERSIST | Never give up; continue |
| DOES | +ILI | DOILIES | Lace table pads |
| LOOT | +SES | LOOSEST | Least tight |

We can then read BILE down the center of the new added triplets; without a clue, but with knowledge of the pattern, it shouldn't be too hard to extend one more time to BICYCLE.
